

TRAILER RACE RULES NO TRAILERS UNDER 5'X8' ALLOWED- TONGUE IS NOT INCLUDED!! NO FLAT STYLE TRAILERS REMEMBER – IF IT DOESN'T SAY YOU CAN DO IT – DON'T!!

The object of the trailer race is to be the first car with a trailer still attached across the finish line at the end of the race. If the trailer comes off during the race – you will be disqualified.

*Open to any 4-cylinder, V6, V8, enduro, or demo type car. ENGINE MUST BE STOCK – PERIOD! **S10 style 4x4 pickups are allowed – Full size pickups are not allowed*

*The use of a Loop Bar is MANDATORY - it must be supported.

*There must be a window net on the driver's side window.

*You must be at least 16 years old. If you are under 18 years old, you must have a signed and notarized parental permission form on file at the Speedway.

*All Drivers' must have a pit pass, or you will not be allowed in the pits.

*Best trailer of show will receive a \$100 bonus.

TRAILER RULES –

- 1. Must be a camping travel trailer or boat trailer. Exterior must be intact. The Trailer may be gutted.
- 2. All Propane and Holding tanks MUST be removed prior to coming to the track.
- 3. All glass must be removed from trailers prior to coming to the track.
- 4. Any bumper or frame-mounted hitch is allowed. The hitch must be securely bolted and/or welded to the bumper or frame. SAFETY CHAINS ARE A MUST!
- 5. There must be slack in the safety chains.
- 6. No sway controls or weight distributing hitches will be allowed.
- 7. No jack posts below the frame will be allowed.
- 8. The trailer MUST be a minimum of five (5) feet wide by eight (8) feet long from where the body of the trailer starts to the end of the trailer. <u>The length of the tongue does not</u> <u>count.</u>

Winning cars must be inspected after the race and any of the above rules that are in violation will result in disqualification.

ENTRIES ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS!!

ALL RULES AND GUIDELINES WILL BE INTERPRETED AND ENFORCED BY THE TECH INSPECTORS WHO MAY DISQUALIFY ANY CAR DEEMED BY THEM TO BE UNSAFE FOR ANY REASON.
